## TOWNSHIP OF HELLAM YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

## FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT CREATING A COUNTY BOARD OF APPEALS

**THIS AMENDMENT** is made the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April, 2025, by and among the County of York, Pennsylvania (the "County") and the Township of Hellam, which executed the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement Creating a County Board of Appeals (the "Agreement"). The County and each Participant shall individually be referred to as a "Party" and shall collectively be referred to as the "Parties".

## **INTENDING TO BE LEGALLY BOUND**, the parties agree as follows:

- Board Membership. The requirements for members of the County Board are hereby adjusted pursuant to the provisions of County Ordinance 2024-3. Specifically, a member or alternative member of the County Board shall be qualified by training and experience to pass on matters pertaining to building construction. Training and experience may consist of licensure as an architect or engineer, experience in the construction industry and training and experience as an inspector or plan reviewer.
- Meetings. The County Board may meet remotely, in accordance with applicable law.
- Full Force and Effect. Except as set forth herein, all provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties hereto have caused this Amendment to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement Creating a County Board of Appeals to be executed on this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April, 2025.
