#### Stormwater Task Force Update

Township- Summary Background information- Feb. 2022 to current (5 minutes)

- Feb. 2022- Board of Supervisors (BOS) identified need for climate resiliency action for Kreutz Creek Watershed.
- Feb. 2022- Task Force formed to identified and research issues, meet with residents, seek partners and develop course of action.
- March 2022- First meeting with residents and formed partnership with Center for Water Quality Excellence (CWQE). 4 action items.
  - Identify target area of watershed (Spring Road to Route 462).
  - Tour watershed and continue meeting with residents.
  - Identify location/dimension of pipes and culverts on Kreutz Creek Road.
  - Conduct Hydrology Study of identified watershed area.
- May 2022- BOS voted to make Climate Resiliency a top priority and formally approve Task
  Force to move forward with project direction.
- September 2022- CWQE released Kreutz Creek Story Map showing history, issues, actions and grant opportunities.
- November 2022- BOS approved CWQE to conduct Kreutz Creek Road pipe and culvert study.
- November 2022- BOS approved CivicMapper LLC to perform a Hydrology Study (Peak Flow Calculator showing volume and flow) of identified area of Kreutz Creek watershed.
- Jan. 2023- CWQE completed the pipe and culvert study and provided pertain information to CivicMapper for their Hydrology Study.
- Jan. 2023- CWQE released the Stormwater Reporter tool which allows residents to input their stormwater/flooding concerns (information and location of issue).
- April 2023- CivicMapper LLC completed Hydrology Study.
- May 2023- CivicMapper LLC finished final reports and Arc GIS information for use by CWQE and Township.
- March 2022 to May 2023- 5 walking tours of watershed, numerous meetings with residents and the involvement/discussions with 3 engineering firms have been done
- May 2023- Starting preparation for application for a Growing Greener Plus grant from DEP (due in June 2023).
- April-May 2023- support letters from YCPC (WAY) and YCCD.
