Junk Dealer's License Application

Section 66 of the Holyoke Code of Ordinances

Junk: All worn out and discarded articles and material in general that may be treated so as to be used again in some form. Glass bottles, rags, waste paper and other articles and materials, when worn out and discarded, are defined as junk.

Old metals: Any metal or article made from any metal which has been worn and used.

Dealer in junk, old metals: A person engaged in the purchase, sale, barter or exchange of junk, old metals whether at retail or wholesale and whether large or small quantities of junk, old metals are bought, sold or bartered.

Said license runs from May 1 to April 30 of each year; regardless of application date.

*Every person dealing in junk, old metals, rags, papers, bottles or secondhand articles or keeping a shop for the purchase, sale or barter of the same shall keep a book in which he/she shall record in plain English language, at the time of every purchase by him of any of the aforesaid articles, a description of the article purchased, the name, age and residence of the person from who and the day and hour when so purchased.

Such book at all times shall be open to the Mayor and City Council or any person authorized to make such examination.

**No dealer or keeper of a shop shall directly or indirectly purchase or receive by way of barter or exchange any of articles from a minor, knowing or having reason to believe him/her to be such.

***No article purchased or received by a dealer or keeper of a shop for the purchase, sale or barter of junk, old metal or secondhand articles shall be sold until at least 30 days from the date of its purchase or receipt has elapsed.
