SANITARY SEWER ENTRANCE FEES AND SEWER AND DRAIN CONNECTIONS

<u>SANITARY SEWER ENTRANCE TYPE</u>	<u>ENTRANCE FEE</u>
1. Single Family Home	\$550.00
2. Apartment Blocks, Attached Condominiums Townhouses, etc.	\$550.00 For First Unit Plus \$275.00/Unit For Each Additional Unit
3. Motels or Hotels	\$550.00 For First Unit Plus \$50.00/Unit For Each Additional Unit
4. Commercial Buildings	\$0.10 Per Square Foot of Floor Area with a Minimum Charge of \$550. Public Corridors Shall Be Excluded
5. Industrial Buildings	The Greater of \$0.10 Per Square Foot of Floor Area or \$50.00 Per 100 Gallons Per Day Average Flow with a Minimum Charge of \$550.00
6. New Connection Replacing an Existing Connection	50% of the Above Listed Fees

STORM DRAIN AND SEWER CONNECTIONS:

No person will be permitted to discharge sewage or storm drainage from his property into the City's sewer or storm drainage system without approval from the City Engineer and Superintendent of Public Works.

The petitioner shall install, under City supervision, and pay for all labor and material charges that are necessary to install his connection from the main to his property line.

BUILDING PERMIT:

No building permit will be issued unless the petitioner has deposited, by check payable to the City of Holyoke, all necessary Sewer Entrance Fees as determined by the City Engineer and the Board of Public Works.

EFFECTIVE DATE: APRIL 10, 1990

All petitions for sewer service after above date will be subject to above rates where applicable.
