____ 5. The on-premises liquor licensee applying for this amendment of premises possesses liquor liability insurance that covers the additional area described in the above Description of Expanded Premises.

The applicant understands that to constitute a restaurant for Phase II re-opening, the on-premises liquor licensee must be able to serve food to patrons seated at tables in accordance with Massachusetts safety standards for social distancing, including possession of all necessary licenses/permits. No standing consumption at a bar and no open containers beyond the licensed premises can be allowed.

This amendment of premises shall remain in effect until **November 1, 2020** or the date upon which the Governor's "Signed Pre-Opening Phase II Order 6.1.20" is rescinded, whichever is sooner, at which point the license will revert to its status prior to approval of amended premises.
