IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND AND TWENTY

ONE THOUSAND TWENTY-SIXTH AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 86 OF THE REVISED
CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HOLYOKE, MASSACHUSETTS 1997

AN ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Holyoke as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 86-92 entitled "General prohibitions" of Division I entitled "General" of Article IV entitled "Stopping, Standing, Parking" of Chapter 86 entitled "Traffic and Vehicles" of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Holyoke, Massachusetts, 1997, as amended, is hereby further amended by the following:

DELETING:

86-92(2) in its entirety


ADDING in its place:

86-92(2) Upon any crosswalk or within 20 feet of any crosswalks at existing intersection or 20 feet of any crosswalk at mid-block crossings or new or reconstructed intersections.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect on the date of passage.
