

IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND AND TWENTY-TWO

AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 2 OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HOLYOKE, MASSACHUSETTS 1997

AN ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Holyoke as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2-232 entitled “Duties generally”, Division 8 entitled “City Engineer/Assistant Superintendent of Public Works” of Article II entitled “Officers and Employees Generally” of Chapter 2 entitled “Administration” of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Holyoke, Massachusetts, 1997, as amended, is hereby further amended:

BY STRIKING THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE:

“The assistant superintendent shall have a Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from an accredited college, a minimum of five years civil engineering experience, including consulting and municipal work, as a professional engineer, and progressive, responsible experience in municipal public works construction and maintenance, three of which involve supervisory responsibilities, or any equivalent combination of education and experience. The assistant superintendent shall be a registered Massachusetts professional engineer.”

AND REPLACE WITH THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE:

“The assistant director shall have a Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from an accredited college, a minimum of five years civil engineering experience, including consulting and municipal work as a professional engineer, and progressive responsible experience in municipal public works construction and maintenance, three of which involve supervisory responsibilities, or any equivalent combination of education

and experience. The assistant director shall be a registered Massachusetts professional engineer.”

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
