

**RESOLUTION TO THE CITY COUNCIL
ADOPTING THE
FFY2022 ANNUAL PLAN
COVERING THE
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM
AND
HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP (HOME) PROGRAM**

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WHEREAS, the housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, provides financial assistance to units of local government through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program for the purpose of undertaking activities to develop viable communities; and

WHEREAS, Title II of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act created the HOME Program to strengthen public-private partnerships to facilitate the development of affordable housing and the cities of Holyoke, Chicopee and Westfield have formed a Consortium for the purpose of participating in said Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Holyoke has been advised by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) that Holyoke's CDBG entitlement amount for the program year beginning July 1, 2022 is projected to be approximately \$1,266,244. and the Consortium HOME award is projected to be \$804,038. which will be distributed per the Consortium Agreement as follows: (amounts are subject to change)

Holyoke	\$424,532.
Chicopee	\$258,096.
Westfield	\$121,410.

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the City Council of Holyoke as follows:

1. That the 2022 Annual Plan be adopted, including the projected uses of funds and all understandings, certifications and assurances therein; and
2. That the aforementioned CDBG and HOME funds as approximated be accepted in furtherance of the purposes of the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan.
3. That the Mayor of the City of Holyoke be designated as the authorized representative of the City and be directed to act on the City's behalf in connection therewith.
