IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND AND TWENTY-TWO

AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 2 OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HOLYOKE, MASSACHUSETTS 1997

AN ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Holyoke as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2-67 entitled "Resident requirement for department heads", Division 1 entitled "GENERALLY" of Article II entitled "Officers and Employees Generally" of Chapter 2 entitled "Administration" of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Holyoke, Massachusetts, 1997, as amended, is hereby further amended:

BY REMOVING THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE:

No person shall serve as a department head in the city unless such person is and remains a resident of the city for the duration of their employment. This subsection shall be inapplicable to the Personnel Department insofar as the Personnel Administrator shall be exempt from the residency requirement.

BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE:

No person shall serve as a department head in the city unless such person is and remains a resident of the city for the duration of their employment. This subsection shall be inapplicable to the Personnel Department, the City Solicitor and the Director of Public Works insofar as these positions shall be exempt from the residency requirement.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
