## AN ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Holyoke as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2-34 entitled "Hours of municipal offices and employees", Division 1 entitled "GENERALLY" of Article II entitled "Officers and Employees Generally" of Chapter 2 entitled "Administration" of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Holyoke, Massachusetts, 1997, as amended, is hereby further amended:

BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE (Boldfaced):

(b) The hours of employment of all persons employed in municipal offices, except the office of the city engineer **and the office of the City Solicitor** shall be from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. of each day, except on Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays, and each of the employees shall be entitled to one hour for lunch each day between such hours. The time for such lunch is to be designated by the head of each department in each municipal office, and the total hours of employment for each employee shall be 35 hours each week.

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
