

# IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND AND TWENTY-TWO

## \_\_\_\_\_ AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 2 OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HOLYOKE, MASSACHUSETTS 1997

### AN ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Holyoke as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Division 1 entitled “Generally”, Article II entitled “Officers and Employees Generally” of Chapter 2 entitled “Administration” of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Holyoke, Massachusetts, 1997, as amended, is hereby further amended:

#### BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE

“Section 2.70 – Director of Public Works – Salary under special circumstances

Under special circumstances and with a supermajority approval by the city council; which approval was granted by the City Council during their meeting conducted on August 2, 2022, the starting salary for the next Director of Public Works, which is set by ordinance, may exceed the mid-range salary but shall not exceed the maximum range salary. Special circumstances shall expire upon the hire of the next Director of Public Works. The provisions of this section shall have no effect on any other salary range or pay rate for any other city employee.”

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
