## Holyoke Biking & Pedestrian Committee Meeting November 7, 2022 Minutes

  - **g.** <u>MIM update-</u>Stepanie spoke about translating the brochure into Spanish. She also spoke about applying for an Infrastructure Grant for Lawrence School funding, and the community event happening at the Flats Community Center on November 16 from 6-8:00 PM.
  - **h.** <u>Bicycle-Friendly Application</u>- Kristen mentioned that the application is due in March, 2023, and we will start talking about it at the January meeting.
  - i. <u>Brochure</u>- Chris will e-mail the brochure to all the members for their input, after Ileana and Stephanie mentioned that this brochure was produced quickly for community outreach at the DoorsOpen Holyoke event. A discussion followed, and everyone was reminded that a sub-committee was formed to produce the brochure; Chris mentioned that when she had e-mailed members for content, only Price and Liz had responded and it was difficult to come up with content so quickly.
  - **j.** <u>150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary</u>- Shannon spoke about adding the celebration to New Business for the next agenda so that we can start discussing BikePed participation.
