Re: <u>VETO</u>: Ordered, That an ordinance be created that requires a department head to report (with an incident report explaining the cause) of any loss in their department over \$250 in value to the City Council and Mayor within 30 days.

Dear Councilors,

Every employee has the responsibility to assist the City in complying with policies and laws and in reporting violations or loss. As Mayor, it's expected for the support and cooperation of all employees in meeting the City's commitment and responsibility to such compliance.

Currently, our appointed city officials accountable for day-to-day and department heads are responsible for instituting and maintaining a system of internal controls to reasonably ensure the prevention and detection of any fraud, misappropriations, losses, and other irregularities. As Mayor together with our City Auditor, and City Treasurer, depending on the issue, we have the primary responsibility for investigating all activity regarding violations or loss, and to the extent practical, will notify the City Council of reported allegations upon commencing an investigation.

We are working on strengthening internal controls so that we safeguard our resources and ensure greater accountability. This includes adopting a Financial Management Policies and Procedures manual that the Division of Local Services is drafting for us. This manual would include definitions, guidelines, and responsibilities regarding appropriate actions. For these reasons, I don't think we need to make this law, therefore I am vetoing. However, I request for the council to send this back to committee so we can work together on this financial management policies and procedures we look forward to present in near future that may be able to satisfy the intent behind this order.
