

IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND AND TWENTY-TWO

AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 42 OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HOLYOKE, MASSACHUSETTS 1997

AN ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Holyoke as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2-40 entitled "Vacation leave-Generally" of Division 1 entitled "Generally" of Article II entitled "Officers and Employees Generally" of Chapter 2 entitled "Administration" of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Holyoke, Massachusetts, 1997, as amended, is hereby further amended:

BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE:

"(h) Under special circumstances, the Mayor may grant vacation time for a new employee set by ordinance that exceeds the minimum but may not exceed 4 weeks. Such special circumstances shall be determined by a 2/3 supermajority of the City Council and shall have no effect on any other time off benefits for any city employee. The provision of this subparagraph shall apply to the hiring of a new Director of Public Works in accordance with the provisions of Section 2-70 herein."

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
