## Re: Annual Report Pursuant to the Host Community Agreement by and between Rise Holdings, Inc. and the City of Holyoke

Dear Mr. Vega:

Please accept this correspondence on behalf of Rise Holdings, Inc. ("**Rise**" or the "**Operator**") relative to its conformance with all requirements set forth by its Host Community Agreement ("**HCA**") with the City of Holyoke (the "**City**"), pertaining to Rise's operations of a Marijuana Retailer at 28 Appleton Street (the "**Establishment**"). The Applicant respectfully submits that it has satisfied all requirements outlined in the HCA (the "**City of Holyoke Requirements**") as outlined below

- City of Holyoke Requirement: The gross revenue for the preceding calendar year. The report shall specify the Host Community Fee as calculated under this section. Rise Response: The gross revenue of the Establishment in 2022 was \$34,221,241. Please refer to Exhibit A for a monthly breakdown of gross revenue. In compliance with Chapter 180 of the Acts of 2022, the Establishment's Host Community Fee for the relevant period is \$912,060.01.
- 2. City of Holyoke Requirement: Any seed-to-sale tracking records required to be reported to the Cannabis Control Commission ("CCC") under 935 CMR 500.105(8)(e) and .105(9)(c)

**3.** City of Holyoke Requirement: Descriptions of any incidents on-site at the Establishment that required a public safety response.

**Rise Response:** There were six (6) incidents on-site at the Establishment that required a public safety response in 2022. Please find copies of the Incident Reports attached herein as **Exhibit B.** 

4. City of Holyoke Requirement: Records pertaining to the Operator's employment level and the number of Holyoke residents employed at the Establishment.

**Rise Response:** The Establishment currently employs 96 individuals. 23 of these employees are Holyoke residents.

5. City of Holyoke Requirement: A description of the measures taken to fulfill the workforce hiring commitment outlined in the HCA.

**Rise Response:** Rise has partnered with the Holyoke Community College to pursue its workforce hiring commitment. Rise accepts students from Holyoke Community College's Cannabis Education Center as interns and employees.

Rise prioritizes local hiring efforts within the Holyoke area through online job posting practices and routine on-site interview opportunities.

Please be advised that Rise has not yet obtained licenses from the Cannabis Control Commission to operate at 100 Water Street.

**Event:** Police called to monitor parking lot during end of day departures

#### **Description of event:**

An employee was terminated from RISE on Friday, July 8, 2022, for making threatening gestures toward another RISE employee. The terminated employee's significant other continues to work at RISE. The terminated employee drove their significant other to work on the morning of Monday, July 11, 2022. As the terminated employee was dropping their significant other off at RISE the terminated employee made threatening gestures toward multiple RISE employees. RISE employees park in a City of Holyoke parking lot located across the street from the RISE facility. The Holyoke Police were notified and scheduled to monitor the parking lot at the end of the day on Monday, July 11, 2022, when RISE employees were walking to their cars. No further incidents occurred while the police were monitoring the parking lot.

#### Investigation:

Security footage of the original threating gesture was reviewed and confirmed to be a threat toward the other employee. Multiple employees reported threatening gestures made toward them by the terminated employee on the morning of Monday, July 11, 2022. The Holyoke Police Department took notes on the incident and have not yet completed a police report.

#### **Preventive Actions:**

Continue to deactivate an employee's agent registration and employee badge access whenever an employee's employment is terminated. Continue to monitor the current situation and escalate to law enforcement as needed. Continue to schedule police presence whenever there is a credible concern for the safety of employees.

#### **Corrective Action:**

Continue to encourage employees to report any threats made against them and/or any safety concerns they have. Continue to investigate any accusations of employees making threats of violence toward any other employees.

SANTIAGO proceeded to give the middle finger towards BOUTIN before driving off. I advised FATHALLAH a report would be on file and if SANTIAGO returned to call us back and we would issue a trespass notice.

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**Incident:** Thursday, September 8, 2022, at approximately 8:35 AM EST

**Event:** Fire Department Responded to Fire Alarm at RISE Holdings, Inc.

#### **Description of event:**

On Thursday, September 8, 2022, at approximately 8:35 AM the fire alarm sounded at RISE Holdings, Inc. All employees evacuated the building and the Holyoke Fire Department responded to the facility.

#### Investigation:

A foliar treatment was being applied to the plants in the mother room with a cold fogger and the air handler pulled the treatment into the duct work which triggered the particle sensor smoke detector to alarm. The same treatment method is typically used in the mother room but this time more treatment was applied. The additional treatment caused a denser fog which set of the particle sensor smoke detector. Upon arrival the fireman inspected the mother room, determined that the building was safe, and all employees returned to the building.

#### **Preventive Actions:**

Employees will turn off the air handler in the mother room when using the cold fogger for foliar treatment.

#### **Corrective Action:**

All employees evacuated the building when the alarm sounded. The fire department entered the building and determined the building was safe for employees to re-enter.

**Event:** Fire Department Responded to Fire Alarm

#### **Description of event:**

At 11:47 AM EST the fire alarm sounded at RISE Holdings, Inc. The Holyoke Fire Department responded to the alarm and entered the building.

#### Investigation:

The maintenance department was using a circular saw on the floor of a room to repair a defect on the floor. The room was free of additional people and marijuana products. The maintenance team set up a portable dust collection system to collect the dust from the grinder. The dust collection system did not collect all the dust and, as a result, some dust was pulled into the air handling system which contains a smoke detector. The dust blocked the particle detection light in the smoke detector which triggered the fire alarm.

#### **Preventive Actions:**

Use a wet saw or equivalent on future projects that require concrete cutting.

#### **Corrective Action:**

All employees evacuated the building to the designated evacuation area across the street. Employees waited for the Fire Department's permission to reenter the building.
