Grant Purpose

The City of Holyoke is looking to improve pedestrian and bicycle safety along the Main Street - Springdale Corridor. The Main Street - Springdale Corridor provides an essential connection from the southern portion of the city to the flats (downtown) area. The corridor connects downtown Holyoke to Route 5 in West Springfield and is situated between the Connecticut River and Route 5. The objective of the project is to incorporate multi-modal safety improvements, through complete street design elements, including the construction of an adjacent shared-use path in order to enhance access to key destinations along the corridor, provide connections to points north and south and improve pedestrian accessibility, access and mobility along the corridor. This project was to survey and draft preliminary shared-use path designs along the Main Street - Springdale corridor. A design team was hired to create different shared-use path design proposals that best fit the needs for the space and people in the area. The design includes details on costs and phases of implementation of the shared-use path. With this grant funding, we were able to fund a topographic survey of the corridor and a 10% design plan has been created.
