b. HEDIC Financial Update

John Dyjach provided a brief financial update that staff moved approved funds in the amount of \$1 million into a 10-month certificate of deposit account at a 4.5% interest. There has been little activity in the account balances since the last update but due to increased interest rates there has been significant earned interest. Expenses of note included the annual insurance payment and the translation services for the HEDIC MakerLoan Program documents. The Redevelopment Authority continues to transfer payments for the Aegis Jackson Canal Loan. The Chair thanked staff for the update and opened the floor for questions or comments. Callie Flanagan asked if the property assets listed on the financial update have use restrictions and restrictions on who could potentially purchase the properties. Mr. Dyjach responded that HEDIC is limited to industrial use that has a benefit to the city. There are some unique cases such as the land on Whiting Farms Rd. which is part of an economic development plan with the HG&E in which the HG&E has the final say on sales.
