Pursuant to the Mississippi Tax Increment Financing Act, Title 21, Chapter 45, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended (the "Act"), the City is authorized to undertake and carry out redevelopment projects, as defined therein, utilizing tax increment financing ("TIF"), and also to carry out such projects jointly with other local government units, pursuant to the Regional Economic Development Act, Title 57, Chapter 64, Mississippi Code as amended (the "REDA Act") or the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Title 17, Chapter 13, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended (the "Interlocal Act").
- 2. The Council has previously conducted hearings on and approved and adopted the *Tax Increment Financing Plan, The District Project, City of Jackson, Mississippi, May 2013 (the* (the "TIF Plan"). The TIF Plan constitutes a qualified plan under the Act.
- 3. Under the TIF Plan, The District Land Development Company, LLC, a Mississippi limited liability company, (the "Developer") proposed to develop an upscale, mixed-use development at the former location of the Mississippi School for the Blind to be known as "The District" (hereinafter the "Project") in the City and in the proposed tax increment financing district (the "TIF District"), as was more particularly described in the TIF Plan. The Project includes a bank, restaurants, a hotel, shopping and infrastructure improvements, together with residential flats. In the TIF Plan it was contemplated that the Project would be completed in phases with TIF Bonds to be issued in one or more series. Approximately 70% of the Project has been completed to date.
- 4. The site of the Project was in need of development and redevelopment, and the proposed Project will provide a significant boost to the City's economy, is in the best interest of the public health, safety, morals and welfare of the City and is a project eligible for Tax Increment Financing as set forth in the TIF District plan adopted by the City in 2013.
- 5. As authorized by the Act, the Governing Body has determined the necessity of providing funds for certain site and infrastructure improvements relating to the Project, which may include, but are not necessarily limited to, the demolition of buildings, installation, rehabilitation and/or relocation of utilities such as water, sanitary sewer, construction, renovation, or rehabilitation of drainage improvements, roadways, curbs and gutters, sidewalks, on-site parking, parking structures, relocation of electrical lines, lighting, signalization, landscaping of rights-of way, related architectural/engineering fees, attorney's fees, TIF Plan preparation fees, issuance costs, capitalized interest, and other related soft costs (together the "Infrastructure Improvements").
- 6. It is necessary and in the public interest for the City to issue the bonds pursuant to the TIF Plan in an amount not to exceed \$7,000,000 (the "TIF Bonds") to finance or reimburse the Developer for a portion of the cost of the Infrastructure Improvements.
- 7. That in order to prepare the necessary resolution and documents for the sale and issuance of the TIF Bonds, it is in the best interest of the City to authorize the law firms of Charles E. Carpenter; The Howard Law Firm; and Winston J. Thompson III and Associates as Bond Counsel to prepare and distribute such resolutions and documents necessary in order to facilitate the consideration and approval of the sale and issuance of such TIF Bonds subject to the approval of the Governing Body of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, ACTING FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Governing Body hereby declares its intention to issue the TIF Bonds of the City in one or more series in such amount as shall be determined by further action to raise money for the improvements.

SECTION 2. The Governing Body herein authorizes the Mayor to employ the law firms of Charles E. Carpenter; The Howard Law Firm; and Winston J. Thompson III and Associates and subsequently authorize them to prepare and distribute such resolutions and documents necessary in order to facilitate the sale and issuance of the TIF Bonds at a subsequent date subject to the approval of the Governing Body of the City for a fee of not more than \$35,000.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI, AUTHORIZING THE ENGAGEMENT OF CERTAIN PROFESSIONALS IN CONNECTION WITH THE SALE AND ISSUANCE OF TAX INCREMENT LIMITED OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY, SERIES 2018 TO RAISE MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR CERTAIN SITE AND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS RELATING TO THE WESTIN HOTEL PROJECT IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,750,000); AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Jackson, Mississippi (the "Governing Body" of the "City"), acting for and on behalf of the City, hereby finds, determines, adjudicates and declare as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to the Mississippi Tax Increment Financing Act, Title 21, Chapter 45, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended (the "Act"), the City is authorized to undertake and carry out redevelopment projects, as defined therein, utilizing tax increment financing ("TIF"), and also to carry out such projects jointly with other local government units, pursuant to the Regional Economic Development Act, Title 57, Chapter 64, Mississippi Code as amended (the "REDA Act") or the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Title 17, Chapter 13, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended (the "Interlocal Act").
- 2. The Council has previously conducted hearings on and approved and adopted the *Tax Increment Financing Plan, The Westin Hotel Project, City of Jackson, Mississippi, June 2013* (the "TIF Plan"). The TIF Plan constitutes a qualified plan under the Act.
- 3. Under the TIF Plan, Capital Hotel Associates, LLC, a Mississippi limited liability company, (the "Developer") proposed to develop a project to be known as "The Westin Hotel Project" (hereinafter the "Project") in the City and in the proposed tax increment financing district (the "TIF District"), as was more particularly described in the TIF Plan. The Project includes a full-service luxury hotel encompassing an entire city block bound by streets Tombigbee, Court, Congress and West, and including the former Mississippi Valley Title Building.
- 4. The site of the Project was in need of development and redevelopment, and the proposed Project will provide a significant boost to the City's economy, is in the best interest of the public health, safety, morals and welfare of the City and is a project eligible for Tax Increment Financing as set forth in the TIF District plan adopted by the City in 2013.

- 5. As authorized by the Act, the Governing Body has determined the necessity of providing funds for certain site and infrastructure improvements relating to the Project, which may include but are not limited to, demolition of buildings, installation, rehabilitation and/or relocation of utilities such as water, sanitary sewer, construction, renovation, or rehabilitation of drainage improvements, roadways, curb and gutters, sidewalks, on-site parking, parking structures, relocation of electrical lines, landscaping of rights-of-way, related architectural/engineering fees, attorney's fees, TIF Plan preparation fees, issuance costs, capitalized interest, and other related soft costs (the "Infrastructure Improvements")
- 6. It is necessary and in the public interest for the City to issue bonds pursuant to the TIF Plan Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$1,750,000 (the "TIF Bonds") to finance or reimburse the Developer for a portion of the cost of the Infrastructure Improvements.
- 7. That in order to prepare the necessary resolution and documents for the sale and issuance of the Bonds, it is in the best interest of the City to authorize the law firms of Charles E. Carpenter; The Howard Law Firm; and Winston J. Thompson III and Associates as Bond Counsel to prepare and distribute such resolutions and documents necessary in order to facilitate the consideration and approval of the sale and issuance of such Bonds subject to the approval of the Governing Body of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, ACTING FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Governing Body hereby declares its intention to issue the TIF Bonds of the City in one or more series in such amount as shall be determined by further action to raise money for the improvements.

SECTION 2. The Governing Body herein authorizes the Mayor to employ the law firms of Charles E. Carpenter; The Howard Law Firm; and Winston J. 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ORDER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI REVISING FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018 BUDGET TO FUND A DISPARITY AND AVAILABLITY STUDY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson is concerned about the participation of minority and women business enterprises in the public procurement process and is dedicated to addressing past discriminatory practices which have affected minority businesses and female business owners; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson desires equity for all and supports opportunities to better understand the level of participation of minority and women-owned businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson City Council realizes that to better understand the marketplace in the City of Jackson, an analysis of the availability, utilization and disparity among minority and women-owned businesses is needed; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson has conducted numerous disparity studies in the past that have documented discriminatory practices and barriers to public procurement in the City of Jackson; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Supreme Court, in City of Richmond v J.A. Croson & Co, held that a state or local subdivision has the authority to eradicate the effects of private discrimination within its own legislative jurisdiction and has further found that local subdivision can use its spending powers to remedy private discrimination by taking affirmative steps to dismantle such a system, if it identifies that discrimination with the particularity required by the Fourteenth Amendment and if the City can show that it had essentially become a "passive participant" in a system of racial exclusion; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson City Council passed an ordinance on June 30, 2015, mandating that a disparity and availability study be conducted at least every five years.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the City Council of Jackson, Mississippi that up to \$105,000 is taken from Account Number 001-3550, the Fund Balance, for the purpose of procuring a company to conduct a Disparity and Availability Study within the next 60 days.
