- Siemens Contract Audit and Contract Management-maximize value of Siemens contract
- Siemens Contract Business Plan-maximize value of Siemens contract
- Infrastructure Tax Analysis and Master Plan Development-to help ensure that the City can utilize Infrastructure Tax revenue in the most efficient manner.
- Miscellaneous Assistance-assist with responses to Moody's questions, assist with Green Infrastructure challenge, review Fiserv contract and determine financial impact of mischarging accounts >1 mile outside City.

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President Stamps recognized **James Covington** of iVision IT Consultants, introduced **Pam Glanville** of Origin Consultants, who provided an overview of the integration system for the City's water billing system.
