Symptoms

Symptoms may appear 2 to 14 days after exposure.



Slow the Spread

If hand washing is not available, use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.



Social Distancing

- Avoid public gatherings, especially if sick people are present.
- Maintain a minimum 6 feet of distance from others.
- Avoid sharing objects.
- Wash your hands and sanitize surfaces.

If You're Sick

- Avoid close contact with others to limit spread.
- If symptoms are mild, treat in place with OTC fever reducers, rest & fluids.
- If symptoms are severe or worsen after getting better, call a medical provider and seek care.
