## General Guidelines for Group Gatherings

## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR GROUP GATHERINGS WITH SOCIAL DISTANCING:

- Group gatherings where individuals are able to maintain a minimum of 6 feet separation are limited to no more than 50 people in a single indoor space.
- Group gatherings where individuals are able to maintain a minimum of 6 feet separation are limited to no more than 100 people in an outdoor space.


## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR GROUP GATHERINGS WHERE SOCIAL DISTANCING IS NOT POSSIBLE:

- Group gatherings are limited to groups of no more than 20 people in a single indoor space where social distancing is not possible.
- Group gatherings are limited to groups of no more than 50 people in an outdoor space where social distancing is not possible.
- Any individual who is over age two and able to medically and physically tolerate a face-covering (a mask or cloth face covering) shall be required to cover their nose and mouth with a face covering when in a public indoor or outdoor place when social distancing of six-feet between individuals cannot be consistently maintained.
