

Guidance for Indoor Recreation and Amusement

STATUS: Open with Restrictions

Indoor recreation and amusement are allowed to open under the limitations in Governor Reeves' Executive [Order 1492](#) summarized below

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL RECREATION

- Continue following the Guidance for All Employers.
- Employees must wear face coverings (when tolerated medically and physically) when social distancing of six-feet between individuals cannot be consistently maintained.
- Customers are required to wear face coverings (when tolerated medically and physically) when social distancing of six-feet between individuals cannot be consistently maintained.
- Prior to resuming operations, the indoor place of amusement, including areas not open to the public, shall be deep cleaned, disinfected and sanitized.
- Indoor Recreation and Amusement shall conduct a daily screening of all employees at the beginning of their shifts and customers upon entry. Such daily screening shall include the following questions, and any employee answering any question in the affirmative shall be sent home: (1) have you been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days; (2) are you experiencing a cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat; (3) have you had a fever in the last 48 hours; (4) have you had new loss of taste or smell; and (5) have you had vomiting or diarrhea in the last 24 hours.
- All employees shall be required to report any symptoms of COVID-19 to their supervisor, and any employee who exhibits any of the symptoms of COVID-19 during their shift shall be sent home immediately and advised to consult with their physician.
- Break rooms shall be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized, and the number of employees in the break room shall be limited to allow for strict social distancing (a minimum of six feet between employees and no gathering of more than ten employees).
- The number of customers in the indoor place of amusement at one time shall be no greater than 50% of maximum capacity to ensure compliance with social distancing protocols.
- Hand sanitizer shall be available to their customers at all points of entry and exit and throughout the indoor place of amusement.
- All equipment, machines and games shall be rearranged to ensure at least six feet of separation between customers.
- Roller skates, bowling balls and shoes, laser tag guns, equipment, including trampolines, and any other item used by customers shall be sanitized and disinfected after each use.
- All high-touch areas, including all door handles shall be sanitized, at a minimum, once every two hours.
- Group gatherings, including special event parties, shall be limited to a maximum of 20 customers.
- The indoor place of amusement, including all equipment, machines and games, shall be wiped down, cleaned and sanitized daily.
