## ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JACKSON REPEALING SECTION 86-401 THROUGH 86-409 OF THE JACKSON CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, Sections 86-401 through 86-409 of the Jackson Code of Ordinances, also known an "An Ordinance of the City of Jackson, Mississippi, Prohibiting Certain Activities Near Health Care Facilities: was adopted by the Governing Authorities on, or about, October 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Authorities have evaluated the ordinance's effect of the rights of various persons, and finds that it should be repealed; and

## **SECTION 1**

That Sections 86-401 thru 86-409 of the Jackson Code of Ordinance are hereby repealed.

## **SECTION 2**

The Governing Authorities has found "good cause", as defined by Section 21-13-11 of the Miss. Code of 1972, for this order to take immediate effect; therefore, Section 1 is immediately effective.
