BE IT REMEMBERED that a Special Meeting of the City Council of Jackson, Mississippi, was convened at City Hall at 10:00 a.m. on November 16, 2020, being the third Monday of said month, when and where the following things were had and done to wit:

The meeting was called to order by **President Aaron Banks**.
