

BE IT REMEMBERED that a Special Meeting of the City Council of Jackson, Mississippi, was called by a majority of the City Council Members and notices having been placed by the Clerk of Council at 2:20 p.m. on Friday, November 6, 2020, in the Clerk of Council's Office, electronic notifications to all Council Members, on the City's website and on the public bulletin board in the City Hall, relative to (1) Order confirming the Mayor's nomination of Dr. Hursie Davis-Sullivan to the Jackson Municipal Airport Authority Board. (2) Order confirming the Mayor's nomination of Cynthia Thompson to the Jackson Public School Board. The meeting was convened at City Hall located at 219 S. President Street at 3:00 p.m. on Monday, November 9, 2020, being the second Monday of said month, when and where the following things were had and done to wit:

Absent: Kenneth Stokes, Ward 3.

The meeting was called to order by **President Aaron Banks**.

ORDER CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S NOMINATION OF DR. HURSIE DAVIS-SULLIVAN TO THE JACKSON MUNICIPAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY BOARD.

WHEREAS, the Jackson Municipal Airport Authority Board consists of five (5) members nominated by the Mayor for a term of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hursie Davis-Sullivan, resident of Ward 5, after evaluation of her qualifications, has been nominated by the Mayor to fill said vacancy.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Mayor's nomination of Dr. Hursie-Davis Sullivan to the Jackson Municipal Airport Authority Board be confirmed with said term to expire October 27, 2025.

Council Member Tillman moved adoption; **Council Member Lindsay** seconded.

ORDER CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S NOMINATION OF CYNTHIA THOMPSON TO THE JACKSON PUBLIC SCHOOL BOARD.

WHEREAS, the Jackson Public School Board consists of seven (7) members, for a term of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia Thompson, resident of Ward 6, after evaluation of her qualifications, has been nominated by the Mayor to fill said vacancy.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Mayor's appointment of Cynthia Thompson to the Jackson Public School Board be confirmed with said term to expire.
