(Parcels: 430-65 & 430-64)

**Petitioner:** Jaafar Mohammed

**Request:** A **Rezoning** of the property on Parcel 430-65 from R-1(Single-family) Residential District to C-2 (Limited) Commercial with a Use Permit to allow for the operation of a drive thru restaurant on Parcels 430-64 & 430-65.
