• Listen to the local news media or weather radio for current emergency information and instructions regarding flooding.

Preparing for a Flood

- Make a plan for your household, including your pets, so that you and your family know what to
 do, where to go, and what you will need to protect yourselves from flooding. Learn and practice
 evacuation routes, shelter plans, and flash flood response. Gather medicines, supplies, including
 non-perishable foods, cleaning supplies, and water for several days, in case you must leave
 immediately or if services are cut off in your area.
- If you are under a flood warning; seek higher ground shelter right away, and do not walk, swim or drive through flood waters. *Turn Around, Don't Drown!* @ www.ready.gov
