**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Jackson Public School District has submitted a certified copy of its Order formally requesting an ad valorem tax levy and officially approving the fiscal year 2021-2022 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to adopt an ad valorem tax levy sufficient to fund said budget;

**IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED** that for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021, there is levied on all taxable property, real and personal, within the Jackson Municipal Separate School District, composed of property both inside and outside the corporate limits of the City of Jackson, the following ad valorem taxes for school purposes, said levies to be collected upon each dollar of assessed value as shown upon the real and personal ad valorem assessment rolls of the said Jackson Municipal Separate School District for Tax Year 2021, to wit;

**ORDER RESCINDING THE MARCH 30, 2021 ORDER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI, AND HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO PROVIDE FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000.00) TO HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO ENGAGE DEPUTIES OF THE SHERIFF OF HINDS COUNTY TO ASSIST WITH PUBLIC SAFETY ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE CITY OF JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI.**

**WHEREAS**, during the City Council meeting on March 30, 2021, the governing body, pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1974 and other applicable law, invoked an order authorizing the Mayor to execute an interlocal agreement between the City of Jackson, Mississippi (“City”) and Hinds County to provide \$500,000.00 to the Hinds County Sheriff Department to hire additional deputies to assist with public safety within the City of Jackson, Mississippi; and

**WHEREAS**, this interlocal cooperative agreement was proposed after careful consideration of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Jackson and recognizing the fact that the Jackson Police Department (JPD) is presently understaffed and in need of tangible assistance; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of the City of Jackson, Mississippi has been unable to reach a finite agreement with Hinds County, Mississippi leadership in a timely manner to define the terms of the aforementioned agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, in the best interest of the citizens of Jackson, Mississippi, the City Council of Jackson, Mississippi is rescinding the order, thereby terminating the authorization of the aforementioned interlocal agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, rescinding this order will unencumber the earmarked funds of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,00.00) to be repurposed for use within the City of Jackson’s budget for first responders.

**THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the March 30, 2021 Order Authorizing the Mayor to Execute An Interlocal Cooperative Agreement Between the City Of Jackson, Mississippi, And Hinds County, Mississippi, to Provide Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,00.00) to Hinds County, Mississippi to Engage Deputies of the Sheriff of Hinds County to Assist with Public Safety Activities Within the City of Jackson, Mississippi is rescinded.

**ORDER TERMINATING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI, HOLMES COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AND THE HOLMES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT FOR THE TEMPORARY HOUSING OF JACKSON POLICE DEPARTMENT ARRESTEES AND UNENCUMBERING FUNDS FOR THE SAME**

**WHEREAS**, during the City Council meeting on October 13, 2020, the governing body, pursuant to applicable law, passed an order authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement between the City of Jackson, Mississippi ("City"), Holmes County, Mississippi, and the Holmes County Sheriff's Department for the temporary housing of Jackson Police Department ("JPD") Arrestees, in particular persons charged with misdemeanors; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the chronic overcrowding of the now consolidated Jackson City Jail and Hinds County Detention Center, the City was forced to seek supplemental jail space to house JPD arrestees; and

**WHEREAS**, Holmes County, Mississippi and the Holmes County Sheriff's Office agreed to provide the City with additional jail space, approximately 12 beds, at the Holmes-Humphreys County/Regional Correctional Facility in Lexington, Mississippi to house JPD arrestees; and

**WHEREAS**, under the proposed one-year term agreement, the City would pay \$31.00 per occupied bed per day. Said cost would include all supplies and equipment, health screening, blankets, water, food and clothing, and routine medical services, which shall be provided to the arrestee(s); and

**WHEREAS**, in the best interest of the citizens of Jackson, Mississippi, the City Council of Jackson, Mississippi agrees to terminate the agreement and unencumber the funds earmarked for said agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, terminating this order will allow funds to be repurposed for use within the City of Jackson's budget for first responders; and

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the order authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement with Holmes County, Mississippi, and Holmes County Sheriff's Office to provide the City with supplemental jail space is hereby rescinded and the agreement is terminated.

**WHEREAS**, due to the chronic overcrowding of the now consolidated Jackson City Jail and Hinds County Detention Center, the City was forced to seek supplemental jail space to house JPD arrestees; and

**WHEREAS**, Yazoo County, Mississippi and the Yazoo County Sheriff's Office agreed to provide the City with additional jail space, approximately 25 beds, at the Yazoo County Regional Correctional Facility in Yazoo City, Mississippi to house JPD arrestees; and

**WHEREAS**, under the proposed one-year term agreement, the City would pay \$25.00 per occupied bed per day. Said cost would include all supplies and equipment, health screening, blankets, water, food, clothing, and routine medical services, which shall be provided to the arrestee(s); and

**WHEREAS**, in the best interest of the citizens of Jackson, Mississippi, the City Council of Jackson, Mississippi agrees to rescind said order and unencumber the funds earmarked for said agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, rescinding this order will allow funds to be repurposed for use within the City of Jackson's budget for first responders.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the order authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement with Yazoo County, Mississippi, and Yazoo County Sheriff's Office to provide the City with supplemental jail space is hereby rescinded.
