**Background Information:**

The last revised resolution was approved by Council on March 24, 2020. Per the Notice received from DPS, the Council will need to approve another revised Interlocal Cooperation Contract for the DPS FTA program due to changes that occurred in the 88<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session. The Jarrell Municipal Court utilizes the DPS Failure to Appear / Failure to Pay Program, to deny the renewal of a driver license if a defendant has failed to appear for a citation or failed to satisfy a judgment ordering the payment of a fine. Their driver license may be denied renewal until the reported citations or violations are cleared and reported by the court to the Department.

**Funding:**

No Change to the funding. The Court will continue to collect a \$10.00 reimbursement fee. \$6.00 of the fee is allocated for payment to DPS. The remaining \$4.00 remains with the City and is credited to the general fund.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Jarrell (“City”) and the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas (“DPS”) have a mutual intent and understanding with respect to the Interlocal Cooperation Contract regarding the revised contract establishing the Failure to Appear (FTA); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Jarrell (“City”) and the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas (“DPS”) will enter into the Interlocal Cooperation Contract attached as “Exhibit A”.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JARRELL, TEXAS:**

That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute an Interlocal Cooperation Contract with the Department of Public Safety, on behalf of the City, under the authority granted in Texas Transportation Code Chapter 706 and Texas Government Code 791, establishing an automated Failure to Appear (FTA) system that accurately stores information regarding violators used to properly deny renewal of a driver’s license.

Due to changes occurring in the 88<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session, the Department revised the FTA contract (ICC). This notice is to inform you of the changes and the need to sign a new contract to continue your participation in the FTA program. You must return the signed contract (ICC) **within 90 days** from the date of this notice to continue participating in the program.

The following changes have been made to the contract (ICC):

- Changes to language and restructuring of the original ICC to provide clarity regarding the specific responsibilities held by each party.
- Inclusion of indigency into the program as mandated by House Bill 291, 88<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session.
- Language to account for future changes to the current statute, either federal or state, ensuring that the ICC remains in compliance with the latest legal requirements until a revised ICC is available.

It is imperative that all participants in the FTA program adhere to these updated terms to ensure the program's continued effectiveness and compliance with relevant legislation. **Interlocal Cooperation Contract  
Failure to Appear Program**

**I. PARTIES AND AUTHORITY**

This Interlocal Cooperation Contract (Contract) is entered into between the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas (DPS), an agency of the State of Texas and the \_\_\_\_\_ Court of the [City or County] of \_\_\_\_\_ (Court), a political subdivision of the State of Texas, referred to collectively in this Contract as the Parties, under the authority granted in Tex. Transp. Code Chapter 706 and Tex. Gov't Code Chapter 791 (the Interlocal Cooperation Act).

**II. BACKGROUND**

A peace officer authorized to issue citations within the jurisdiction of the Court must issue a written warning to each person to whom the officer issues a citation for a traffic law violation. This warning must be provided in addition to any other warnings required by law. The warning must state in substance that if the person fails to appear in court for the prosecution of the offense or if the person fails to pay or satisfy a judgment ordering the payment of a fine and cost in the manner ordered by the Court, the person may be denied renewal of the person's driver license.

As permitted under Tex. Transp. Code § 706.008, DPS contracts with a private vendor (Vendor) to provide and establish an automated Failure to Appear (FTA) system that accurately stores information regarding violators subject to the provisions of Tex. Transp. Code Chapter 706. DPS uses the FTA system to properly deny renewal of a driver license to a person who is the subject of an FTA system entry generated from an FTA Report.

An FTA Report is a notice sent by Court requesting a person be denied renewal of a driver's license in accordance with this Contract. The Court may submit an FTA Report to DPS's Vendor if a person fails to appear or fails to pay or satisfy a judgment as required by law. There is no requirement that a criminal warrant be issued in response to the person's failure to appear.

**III. PURPOSE**

This Contract applies to each FTA Report submitted by the Court to DPS or its Vendor and accepted by DPS or its Vendor.

**IV. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE**

This Contract will be effective on the date of execution and terminate five years from that execution date unless terminated earlier in accordance with Section VII.C, *General Terms and Conditions, Termination*.

**V. COURT RESPONSIBILITIES**

**A. FTA Report**

For a matter involving any offense which a Court has jurisdiction of under Tex. Code Crim. Proc. Chapter 4, where a person fails to appear for a complaint or citation or fails to pay or



satisfy a judgment ordering payment of a fine and cost in the manner ordered by the Court, the Court will supply DPS, through its Vendor, an FTA report including the information that is necessary to deny renewal of the driver license of that person. The Court must make reasonable efforts to ensure that all FTA Reports are accurate, complete, and non-duplicative. The FTA Report must include the following information:

1. the jurisdiction in which the alleged offense occurred;
2. the name of the court submitting the report;
3. the name, date of birth, and Texas driver license number of the person who failed to appear or failed to pay or satisfy a judgment;
4. the date of the alleged violation;
5. a brief description of the alleged violation;
6. a statement that the person failed to appear or failed to pay or satisfy a judgment as required by law;
7. the date that the person failed to appear or failed to pay or satisfy a judgment; and
8. any other information required by DPS.

#### **B. Clearance Reports**

The Court that files the FTA Report has a continuing obligation to review the FTA Report and promptly submit appropriate additional information or reports to the Vendor. The clearance report must identify the person, state whether or not a fee was required, and advise DPS to lift the denial of renewal and state the grounds for the action. All clearance reports must be submitted immediately, but no later than two business days from the time and date that the Court receives appropriate payment or other information that satisfies the person's obligation to that Court.

To the extent that a Court uses the FTA system by submitting an FTA Report, the Court must collect the statutorily required \$10.00 reimbursement fee from the person who failed to appear, pay or satisfy a judgment ordering payment of a fine and cost in the manner ordered by the Court. If the person is acquitted of the underlying offense for which the original FTA Report was filed or found indigent by the court, the Court will not require payment of the reimbursement fee.

Court must submit a clearance report for the following circumstances:

1. the perfection of an appeal of the case for which the warrant of arrest was issued or judgment arose;
2. the dismissal of the charge for which the warrant of arrest was issued or judgment arose;
3. the posting of a bond or the giving of other security to reinstate the charge for which the warrant was issued;
4. the payment or discharge of the fine and cost owed on an outstanding judgment of the Court; or
5. other suitable arrangement to satisfy the fine and cost within the Court's discretion.

After termination of the Contract, the Court has a continuing obligation to report dispositions and collect fees for all violators in the FTA system at the time of termination. Failure to comply with the continuing obligation to report will result in the removal of all outstanding entries of the Court in the FTA Report, resulting in the lifting of any denied driver license renewal status from DPS.

**C. Quarterly Reports and Audits**

Court must submit quarterly reports to DPS in a format established by DPS.

Court is subject to audit and inspection at any time during normal business hours and at a mutually agreed upon location by the state auditor, DPS, and any other department or agency, responsible for determining that the Parties have complied with the applicable laws. Court must provide all reasonable facilities and assistance for the safe and convenient performance of any audit or inspection.

Court must correct any non-conforming transactions performed by the Court, at its own cost, until acceptable to DPS.

Court must keep all records and documents regarding this Contract for the term of this Contract and for seven years after the termination of this Contract, or until DPS or the State Auditor's Office (SAO) is satisfied that all audit and litigation matters are resolved, whichever period is longer.

**D. Accounting Procedures**

Court must keep separate, accurate, and complete records of the funds collected and disbursed and must deposit the funds in the appropriate municipal or county treasury. Court may deposit such fees in an interest-bearing account and retain the interest earned on such accounts for the Court.

Court will allocate \$6.00 of each \$10.00 reimbursement fee received for payment to the Vendor and \$4.00 for credit to the general fund of the municipal or county treasury.

**E. Non-Waiver of Fees**

Court will not waive the \$10.00 reimbursement fee for any person that has been submitted on an FTA Report, unless any of the requirements in Tex. Trans. Code § 706.006(a) or §706.006(d) are met.

Failure to comply with this section will result in: (i) termination of this Contract for cause; and (ii) the removal of all outstanding entries of the Court in the FTA Report, resulting in the lifting of any denied driver license renewal status from DPS.

**F. Litigation Notice**

The Court must make a good-faith attempt to immediately notify DPS in the event that the Court becomes aware of litigation in which this Contract or Tex. Transp. Code Chapter 706 is subject to constitutional, statutory, or common-law challenge, or is struck down by judicial decision.

**VI. DPS's RESPONSIBILITIES**

DPS will not continue to deny renewal of the person's driver license after receiving notice from the Court that the FTA Report was submitted in error or has been destroyed in accordance with the Court's record retention policy.

**VII. PAYMENTS TO VENDOR**

Court must pay the Vendor a fee of \$6.00 per person for each violation that has been reported to the Vendor and for which the Court has subsequently collected the statutorily required \$10.00 reimbursement fee. In the event that the fee has been waived by Tex. Trans. Code § 706.006(a) or §706.006(d), no payment will be made to the Vendor.

Court agrees that payment will be made to the Vendor no later than the last day of the month following the close of the calendar quarter in which the payment was received by the Court.

DPS will not pay Vendor for any fees that should have been submitted by a Court.

**VIII. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- A. **Compliance with Law.** This Contract is governed by and construed under and in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas. The Court understands and agrees that it will comply with all local, state, and federal laws in the performance of this Contract, including administrative rules adopted by DPS.
- B. **Notice.** The respective party will send the other party notice as noted in this section. Either party may change its information by giving the other party written notice and the effective date of the change.

- C. **Termination.**  
 Either party may terminate this Contract with 30 days' written notice.

 If either Party is subject to a lack of appropriations that are necessary for that Party's performance of its obligations under this Contract, the Contract is subject to immediate cancellation or termination, without penalty to either Party.
- D. **Amendments.**  
 This contract may only be amended by mutual written agreement of the Parties.
- E. **Miscellaneous.**
  1. The parties shall use the dispute resolution process provided for in Chapter 2260 of the Texas Government Code to resolve any disputes under this Contract; provided



however nothing in this paragraph shall preclude either Party from pursuing any remedies available under Texas law.

- 2. This Contract shall not constitute or be construed as a waiver of any of the privileges, rights, defenses, remedies, or immunities available to either Party or the State of Texas.
- 3. Any alterations, additions, or deletions to the terms of the contract that are required by changes in federal or state law or regulations are automatically incorporated into the contract without written amendment hereto, and shall become effective on the date designated by such law or by regulation.

**CERTIFICATIONS**

The Parties certify that (1) the Contract is authorized by the governing body of each party; (2) the purpose, terms, rights, and duties of the Parties are stated within the Contract; and (3) each party will make payments for the performance of governmental functions or services from current revenues available to the paying party.

**Background Information:**

The current serviceability of the Taser X26 CEDs have or will expire within the next year. This device has been discontinued for 2024 and will no longer be under warranty. In addition, with the purchase of new vehicles, additional in-car cameras will need to be purchased. The Motorola body worn cameras have also had several issues in providing evidence to local courts and fulfilling open records requests, requiring extensive time and effort of patrol officers. Having these devices operating on separate platforms has caused unintended consequences related to operations, effectiveness, and efficiency. Most agencies have moved to a single source for all these devices to resolve these issues.

Axon has proposed a 10-year plan that will provide all these items to JPD in one bundle. The plan would provide Taser 10 CEDs, body worn cameras, in-car cameras, unlimited evidence storage and other supportive software. These systems would be integrated to function in real time across all platforms, significantly improving day-to-day operations. Over the contract, equipment would be automatically upgraded every four years and provide a substantial cost saving over the plan period compared to purchasing these items independently.

These items are critical to the operations of the police department.

**Funding:**

This item would require an annual amount of \$50,684.58 for the duration of the contract. Funding is available after approval of the associated budget amendment.

Axon Evidence also supports bulk action capabilities that can save users time when managing the system and their evidence. For example, instead of going into the video player interface to perform actions on an individual video, Axon Evidence supports bulk actions that can be performed on one or many selected videos based on search results, which can save time when managing multiple pieces of evidence.

While working with evidence, users will have the ability to review and playback video and audio with our built-in media player. With basic controls that allow a user to play, stop, rewind, fast forward, and control the speed at which evidence files are played, users can quickly and thoroughly review their evidence.

### AXON FLEET 3

Axon Fleet 3 is an in-car video system purpose-built to capture audio and video within and outside of the vehicle. Axon Fleet 3 offers comprehensive evidence capture so that incidents are accurately documented and policing processes become more efficient and purposeful. Evidence captured by the system is stored on the Axon Hub and offloaded to Axon Evidence via LTE or Wi-Fi connections. The system also leverages Automatic License Plate Recognition (ALPR) technology to quickly gather information tied to plate reads.

Axon Fleet 3 also comes equipped with real-time awareness technology that makes livestreaming a video feed from the front-facing camera possible, as well as Axon Signal technology to automatically start a recording if a particular action is taken or a device is engaged.



### AXON FLEET 3 IN THE FIELD

Vehicles equipped with Axon Fleet 3 can capture clear and admissible evidence from two cameras—including a front-facing Dual-View camera and rear-facing Interior Camera—both with four configurable resolutions from 480p to 1080p.

The Dual-View Camera supports a Panoramic mode with a 5:2 aspect ratio. This aspect ratio lessens the view of the vehicle's hood—as well as the sky—when recording, which helps capture a wider view of events happening in front of the vehicle. The camera uses two built-in image sensors and auto-exposure capabilities to record high-quality video in all conditions ranging from dim twilight to bright daylight. This technology helps the camera adjust to a variety of lighting environments as the patrol vehicle moves, including traveling through tunnels and parking garages. Additionally, the use of motion blur technology helps to clearly capture fast-moving objects, which is especially useful when using our ALPR technology to scan license plates in the flow of traffic.

The Interior Camera captures video in full color during daylight operation and automatically transitions to capture video in infrared at night. This infrared technology enables video recording even in total darkness, ensuring any activity taking place within the vehicle's cabin is documented. The Interior Camera has a set aspect ratio of 4:3, which allows the camera to capture video evidence of the back cabin, from door-to-door, and above an occupant's head to below their knees.

Each Axon Fleet 3 camera leverages a multi-microphone setup. The Dual-View Camera has three built-in microphones, and the Interior Camera has two built-in microphones. With these multiple integrated microphones, Axon Fleet 3 can make the most effective use of Axon's audio algorithm—developed in partnership with Nokia—which dramatically improves captured audio. Combining Nokia-OZO's Audio Focus and Audio Windscreen technology with our audio algorithm helps to improve the clarity of speech and reduce unwanted environmental noise in a variety of recording environments.

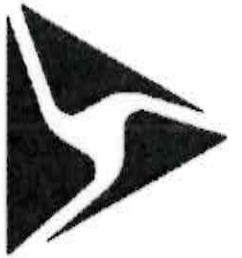

**Item:** Discussion, consideration, and possible action approving the purchase of police vehicles for JPD from Dana Safety Supply Inc.

---

**Department:** Police

**Staff Member:** Patrick South, Chief of Police

**Background Information:**

The current available fleet for JPD consists of 4 patrol vehicles and 2 administrative vehicles that are used to supplement patrol vehicles. Due to the extended use of these vehicles, maintenance and repair costs have already exceeded the annual budget amounts. Both administrative vehicles are in excess of normal milage standards and not intended for normal police operations. Currently, best practices for patrol vehicles recommends reassignment after 70,000 miles for both safety and maintenance reasons. Two of the functioning patrol vehicles are at an acceptable millage for the next 2-3 years of service but would need to be utilized 24/7 if no additional vehicles are purchased.

To meet departmental needs and provide reliable police response to calls for service to the community, the current fleet requires the purchase of additional new vehicles. With anticipated growth and current staff needs, 6 additional vehicles would be needed to ensure a proper fleet rotation, coverage for patrol, administrative needs, and special events.

**Funding:**

This item would approve expenditures in the amount of \$539,891.82 for four 2023 Ford SUV – Police Interceptors and two 2024 Ford Expeditions SSV. Funding is available in the associated budget amendment.
