Water Rate Increase

Water bills mailed in early January 2018 will reflect new rates.

The City of Jarrell will be raising monthly minimum charges on 5/8" x 3/4" meters by \$1.50 for all account holders to be reflected on the bills mailed in early January 2018 for the December 2017 usage. These size meters are typically found on most single-family homes. Meters of greater size are charged more as shown in the chart below. Larger meters have the capability of using more water under normal use. The increased rate is based on equivalents developed by the American Water Works Association and The Texas Rural Water Association. Rates per thousand gallons used are shown below:

1-2,000 gal	\$2.00/1000 gallons
2,001-8,000 g	\$3.80/1000 gallons
8,001-10,000 g	\$5.50/1000 gallons
10,001-20,000 g	\$5.50/1000 gallons
20,001-50,000 g	\$6.00/1000 gallons
Over 50,000 g	\$7.50/1000 gallons
Leak Rate	\$3.10/1000 gallons

The following chart demonstrates the effective change on the Monthly Minimum Charge.
