NOTICE OF 2018 TAX YEAR PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR

City of Jarrell

A tax rate of \$0.419500 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of City of Jarrell. This rate exceeds the lower of the effective or rollback tax rate, and state law requires that two public hearings be held by the governing body before adopting the proposed tax rate.

The governing body of City of Jarrell proposes to use revenue attributable to the tax rate increase for the purpose of growth in demand of services in planning, public safety, recreation and transportation.

The effective tax rate is the total tax rate needed to raise the same amount of property tax revenue for City of Jarrell from the same properties in both the 2017 tax year and the 2018 tax year.

The rollback tax rate is the highest tax rate that City of Jarrell may adopt before voters are entitled to petition for an election to limit the rate that may be approved to the rollback rate.
