

## **Have you received a ticket in the City of Jarrell?...**

**YOU MUST RESPOND, IN WRITING, OR PERSONAL APPEARANCE, TO THE CITATION ON OR BEFORE THE DESIGNATED COURT DATE. PLEASE CONTACT THE COURT IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS. APPEARANCES CANNOT BE MADE BY PHONE.**

**If you fail to respond in person or writing to the charge(s) by your appearance date, an additional charge and fine may be filed against you for violating your promise to appear, warrants issued for your arrest and a hold placed on your driver's license renewal.**

*If you cannot appear in court at the designated time, you must contact the court and request an alternative court date to appear. If the judge determines you do not have sufficient resources or income, alternatives are available to dispose of your fines and court costs.*

Juveniles (16 and under) must appear in person with a parent or legal guardian.

If the defendant is younger than age 17 (juvenile) he/she must appear before the judge with a parent or legal guardian. A juvenile who fails to appear or comply with the court order(s) will have their driver's license suspended as required by law. A child and parent required to appear before the court have an obligation to provide the court, in writing, with the current address and residence of the child. The obligation does not end when the child reaches age 17. On or before the seventh day after the date the child or parent changes residence, the child or parent shall notify the court of the current address in the manner directed by the court. A violation of this subsection may result in an arrest and is a Class C misdemeanor.

- The Jarrell Municipal Court is a non record criminal court established pursuant to the Government Code and the Code of Criminal Procedure of the State of Texas and the Ordinances of the City of Jarrell, Texas.
