

Patrol Officer Position Available at The City of Jarrell

The City of Jarrell is seeking applications for a Patrol Officer. Mission: The Jarrell Police Department is dedicated to providing a safe environment and a high quality of life through service and partnering with the community. The core values: professionalism and integrity.

Brief Job Description: Under general supervision of the Chief of Police, to enforce laws, preserve the peace, apprehend criminals, and investigate traffic accidents and fulfill the mission statement through a community policing orientated service. The Police Chief usually determines deadlines and priorities for this position. Routine course of action to be followed is generally clear-cut and specific in accordance with established Police Department policies; however, incumbent must be able to act quickly in emergencies and make independent decisions. Position requires constant contact with the public in situations that will require the use of tact, diplomacy, and good judgment.

Salary/Benefits: The pay range is \$16.19 to \$24.76 per hour (\$33,675.20 to \$51,500.80 based on a 40-hour work week) and will depend upon background and qualifications of the successful candidate. This position is a non-exempt position and officers are eligible for overtime compensation. The City offers Medical, Life Insurance, 401K Retirement plan, Paid Time Off and 11 Holidays during the calendar year.

The Jarrell Police Department is looking for TCOLE Certified Officers OR men and women who have military experience who were honorably discharged. Military experience can be used in place of being TCOLE Certified. Persons with military experience would be placed in an academy and need to pass physical and academic standards.
