3.2	Consideration and possible action regarding Ordinance No. 2019-0903-02 An Ordinance Of The City Of Jarrell, Texas, Levying Ad Valorem Taxes For Use And Support Of The City Of Jarrell, Texas, For The 2020 Tax Year; Providing For Apportioning Each Levy For Specific Purposes; Providing When Taxes Shall Become Due And When Same Shall Become Delinquent If Not Paid; Providing For Conflicting Ordinances; And Providing Severability, Open Meetings And Effective Date.  Rusty Bryson made a motion that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a rate of 0.419500, which is effectively a 16.673 percent increase in the tax rate, by adopting Ordinance No. 2019-0903-02, An Ordinance Of The City Of Jarrell, Texas, levying ad valorem taxes for use and support of the City of Jarrell, Texas, for the 2020 tax year; providing for apportioning each levy for specific purposes; providing when taxes shall become due and when same shall become delinquent if not paid; providing for conflicting ordinances; and providing severability, open meetings and effective date.
