## **Water Rate Increase**

## Water bills mailed in early January 2020 will reflect new rates.

The City of Jarrell will be raising monthly minimum charges on 5/8" x 3/4" and 3/4" meters by \$3.00 for all account holders, to be reflected on the bills mailed in early **January 2020** for the December 2019 usage. These meters are typically found on most single-family homes. Meters of greater size are charged more, as shown in the chart below. Larger meters have the capability of using more water under normal use. The increase rate is based on equivalents developed by the American Water Works Association and the Texas Rural Water Association.

Rates per thousand gallons used are shown below:

2,001-8,000 gal	\$3.90 / 1,000 gallons	
8,001-10,000 gal	\$5.60 / 1,000 gallons	
10,001-20,000 gal	\$5.60 / 1,000 gallons	
20,001-50,000 gal	\$6.10 / 1,000 gallons	
Over 50,000 gal	\$7.60 / 1,000 gallons	
Leak Rate	\$3.10 / 1,000 gallons
