COMPLIANCE AFFIDAVIT

- 1. You are today being placed on a type of probation for a citation for a period of time set out in your Court Order. You will receive a copy of that Court Order, which states when your probation begins and ends ("Probation Period"). The date your probation ends will be referred to here in as the "Probation Ending Date".
- 2. As a condition to that probation, and without which the citation CANNOT be dismissed, you are required to sign and return to the Clerk the affidavit before a Notary or the Court Clerk, dated and notarized the day of or after the Probation Ending Date. The reason being that it must be signed after the Probation Ending Date is because the offense against the laws of this State or any other State that have resulted in a conviction, and have complied with the terms of your probation. Therefore, you cannot sign it until the Probation Period has ended.
- 3. To sign the affidavit and have it notarized, you can come to the City of Jarrell, 161 Town Center Blvd, Jarrell, TX., request the Affidavit and sign it before a Clerk/Notary. Otherwise, you must sign the Affidavit in front of a Notary Public and have the Notary sign and seal the document and mail it to the Jarrell Municipal Court 161 Town Center Blvd, Jarrell, TX. 76537.
- 4. Your Probation Period will not be satisfied and the citation will not be dismissed until you have properly signed the affidavit before the Notary or the Court Clerk and returned to the Court.
