

COVID-19 Update January 21, 2021

Beginning the new year, Williamson County and Cities Health District has decided not to publish ZIP Code level detail so I am not able to give you local level of detail. So I am only able to give you summary data at the County level.

Since the beginning of the COVID-19 Virus Pandemic a year ago a total of 4.59% of the population has tested Positive AT SOME TIME during the year. Since the beginning of the COVID-19 Virus pandemic a year ago 91.9% have recovered. This recovery percentage has dropped as the volume of new positives has increased.

Since the beginning of the COVID-19 Virus Pandemic a year ago a total of 0.045% of the population has died.

Since the beginning of the COVID-19 Virus Pandemic a year ago 85.3% of the deaths have been in the AGE GROUP of 61+.

Since the beginning of the COVID-19 Virus Pandemic a year ago no one under the age of 18 has died.

The rate of deaths in Williamson County from COVID-19 per population for those under age 61 is 0.0079%.

The rate of deaths in Williamson County from COVID-19 per population for those over age 61 is 0.2208%. This is 27.9 times greater than under age 61.
