3.1 Opened a Public Hearing regarding an amendment to Chapter 4 of the Code of Ordinances to set minimum standards to safeguard the public safety, health, and welfare, insofar as they are affected by building construction, through structural strength, adequate means of egress facilities, stability, sanitary equipment, light and ventilation, energy conservation, fire safety, and in general to promote safety to life and property with the consideration of adoption of the International Building Code 2021.
