Fiscal Year Budget.**

Rusty Bryson made a motion with the budget that requires raising more revenue from property taxes than was raised in the previous year, I make a motion that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.419500, which is effectively a 30.361% increase in the tax rate. - 2.3** Consideration and possible action regarding the Approval of Ordinance No. 2022-0906-02, An Ordinance Of The City Of Jarrell, Texas, Levying Ad Valorem Taxes For Use And Support Of The City Of Jarrell, Texas, For The 2022-2023 Tax Year; Providing For Apportioning Each Levy For Specific Purposes; Providing When Taxes Shall Become Due And When Same Shall Become Delinquent If Not Paid, Providing For Conflicting Ordinances; And Providing Severability, Open Meetings And Effective Date.

The Ordinance caption was read by Mayor Larry Bush. Rusty Bryson made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 2022-0906-02, levying ad valorem taxes at a rate of 0.419500 for use and support of the City of Jarrell, Texas, for the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year, which will raise more taxes for Maintenance and Operations than last year's tax rate, which is effectively a 30.361% increase in the tax rate. Second by Daniel Klepac. The motion passed 3 to 2 by the Mayor breaking a tie vote as listed below:
