Public Works Report March 2024

The Utility Dept. discharged 116,000 gallons per day average at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, with no violations. The bar screen at the head works had an electrical issue that was shortly resolved.

The City billed approximately 3,500,000 gallons of water. The Dept. has not changed any water meters or adjusted the system. Last report, I indicated a 58% loss. I assume that loss ratio has not changed.

Twice this month, we had the opportunity to run our back-up generators due to PEC changing out the voltage in two sections of the City. The CAO rented additional generator units that were placed at the Danz Well Site and the Gonzalas Lift Station to ensure the residents were not negatively impacted by the power loss.

Our emergency generator at the Eagle Well Site is just that: emergency water use. Approx. 150,000 gallons of water can be served with the Eagle Well Site during a single day. With the addition of the generator at the Danz Well Site an additional 400,000 gallons of water was available.

One of our wells had an issue in the control panel on Saturday, March 23rd. It was repaired the following Monday.
