Notice of Planned Water Outages**

The Johnson City Utility Department will repair and/or replace water valves and fire hydrants in the City the week of January 13th and the week of January 20th. The City waited until after the holidays to complete this important work.

To complete this work, water service must be temporarily turned off in various areas throughout the City between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on each day of work. Importantly, the water outage will not be Citywide, but rather, the water outage will affect different areas of the City on different days. Please see schedule and maps below.

The water service outage is expected to affect residential and commercial customers. The Utility Department, in conjunction with its contractor completing the work, will work diligently to restore water service as quickly as possible. Moreover, the Johnson City Volunteer Fire Department will be notified of these planned water outages.

The Utility Department is communicating the planned water outages through social media, Reverse 911, and on its website, www.johnsoncitytx.org. Please communicate / share this information with your neighbors – particularly those that do not utilize social media – so that everyone can be aware of the planned water outages and can properly prepare.
