
1. Call to order

[Note: State law will not permit the City Council to discuss, debate or consider items that are not on the agenda. A limit of 3 minutes is allowed per citizen during public comment.*


6. Discussion and action regarding Housing Authority Water and Garbage Bill and consider a possible reduction of their monthly billing.
