Pursuant to Disaster Declaration No. 2021-D0001, issued under my name and position as Mayor of the City of Johnson City, Texas on February 14, 2021, the City of Johnson City respectfully requests that Blanco County submit a State of Texas Assistance Request (STAR) for de-icing/sanding assistance from the State of Texas for the following roadways:

- Continued de-icing/sanding of U.S. Hwys. 281 and 290;
- Continued de-icing/sanding of Ranch Road 2766 from U.S. Hwy. 281 to North Blanco Co. Emergency Medical Service facility;
- Haley Road (LBJ Nursing Home);
- 600 block of S. Ave. F to U.S. Hwy. 290 (Johnson City Housing Authority and PEC); and
- 400 block of Live Oak to U.S. Hwy. 290 (Johnson City Volunteer Fire Dept.).
