Public Safety

The Police Department successfully made it through the winter storm with no substantial incidents occurring in the City. Throughout the weeklong event we were requested numerous times to assist The Blanco County Sheriff's Office with welfare checks, motor vehicle accidents and other calls for assistance.

On February 1st, Officer Michael Pavlov observed a vehicle entering the west city limits traveling well above the posted 45MPH speed limit. He confirmed the speed of the vehicle with his radar at 68 in a 45MPH speed zone. Officer Pavlov initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle and during his contact with the driver determined him to be under the influence of alcohol. After making the arrest the driver refused to submit to a breath test so a warrant to obtain a blood specimen was requested. The blood warrant was approved, and the specimen taken. This blood was sent to the TXDPS Crime Lab for analysis. Anytime we came take an impaired driver off the roads it's a win for everyone.

On February 20th, Sgt. Scallorn was dispatched to Bryan's on 290 in reference to a fight between a male and female. Upon his arrival Sgt. Scallorn determined that both parties were highly

intoxicated, and the female was the aggressor during the incident. The male subject was placed under arrest for Public Intoxication due to him not have a responsible adult person to be released too. When it came time to place the female into custody see became noncompliant and made several attempts to resist being handcuffed and interfere with the duties of Sgt. Scallorn. In the end she was arrested for PI, Resisting Arrest and Assault.

JOHNSON CITY POLICE DEPT. has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- 2) strictly prohibits peace officers employed by the <u>JOHNSON CITY POLICE DEPT.</u> from engaging in racial profiling;
- 3) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the <u>JOHNSON CITY POLICE</u> <u>DEPT</u>. if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the <u>JOHNSON CITY POLICE DEPT</u>. has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the <u>JOHNSON CITY POLICE DEPT</u>, who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the <u>JOHNSON CITY POLICE DEPT</u>, policy;
- 6) requires collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a warning or citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
 - a. the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
 - b. whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search;
 - c. whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual:
 - d. whether the peace officer used physical force that resulted in bodily injury during the stop;
 - e. the location of the stop;
 - f. the reason for the stop.
- 7) requires the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision (6) to:
 - a. the Commission on Law Enforcement; and
 - b. the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

The <u>JOHNSON CITY POLICE DEPT</u>. has satisfied the statutory data audit requirements as prescribed in Article 2.133 (c), Code of Criminal Procedure during the reporting period.
