The daily average discharge was 180,000 gal per day at the WWTP with no violations.

We billed for 3,197,700 gal of water for the month with a 19% loss. I believe this higher loss was due to multiple fire lines breaking at the Creek View housing complex. (Fire lines are not metered)

The Police Department received new desktop computers that are now linked to the server at City Hall. This hardware update now gives us the ability to back up all documents on City Hall's networks for a more secure retention of PD information.

On March 25<sup>th</sup>, Officer Ethan Bishop was dispatched to a possible Intoxicated Driver call traveling northbound on US HWY 281. Officer Bishop intercepted the vehicle in the 300

of US HWY 281 and observed the driver failing to drive in a single traffic lane. After making a traffic stop Officer Bishop determined that the driver was impaired, and the driver agreed to the submission of a breath test. Upon the completion of the breath test the driver's blood alcohol content was measured at .187 and .194. The legal limit in the State of Texas is 0.08. The subject was arrested and housed at the Blanco County Jail.


On March 3<sup>rd</sup>, Officer Ethan Bishop was dispatched to the Exxon Kwik Chek Gas Station in reference to a welfare concern on a female subject sitting in her vehicle. When Officer Bishop arrived, he began speaking with the female who was seated in the driver's seat of a Chevy Tahoe. Officer Bishop observed several signs of intoxication and at one point the subject got out of her vehicle and began walking away from the scene east on RR 2766. When Officer Bishop attempted to detain her, she pulled away from him several times. When she was finally detained Officer Bishop made attempts to contact was responsible party to release her to but was unsuccessful. The subject was transported to the Blanco County Jail for Public Intoxication.

On March 29<sup>th</sup>, Officer Chad Wiggins was dispatched to a physical disturbance at 301 North Winters Furr #21. Upon arriving Officer Wiggins spoke to a male subject who advised he was assaulted by his girlfriend and she had left the residence. Officer Wiggins reported that the male subject had an injury to the right side of his head near his temple caused by him being struck with a set of keys. Several hours later Officer Wiggins was requested back to the apartment due to the female suspect returning and more arguing occurring. Officer Wiggins contacted me and the County Attorney to get approval to make and onsite arrest due to there being an extended period from the original assault taking place. The County Attorney and I agreed that further violence would probably continue if the parties were not separated so Officer Wiggins made an arrest on the aggressor. The female was transported to the Blanco County Jail.

We had a big response to the Warrant Round-Up, considering we don't have any warrants that are being pursued currently. GHS sent out a Warrant Round-Up notice to any Defendant that had a "Warrant Fee" in their fees, meaning they have a warrant that is lingering. We will start issuing Warrants and Capias Pro Fines soon. Going through the old Warrants has been a slow process.

We had our first Hearing on March 25. We kept it to a smaller docket to ease Judge Walston in. There was a good turnout. We were able to close a few cases out and set some Deferral orders that have already been executed & disposed of. Virtual hearings have opened up the opportunity for out-of-towners to appear, i.e. we had a Defendant from Oklahoma appear and several different parts of Texas. Judge Walston and I have discussed the possibility of having a virtual docket as an option, once we start in-person hearings again.

We closed March with our City's incoming collections totaling \$11,948.08. February's collection was \$5,706.41. This total is after subtraction the State's remittance. We closed 53 cases in March, 24 in February. We started the month with 1380 cases pending, ended the month with 1334 cases pending.
