Public Safety

On April 8th, Officer Ethan Bishop was dispatched to a reckless driver call near the Valero Gas Station on US HWY 281. Officer Bishop was able to locate a vehicle in the Valero parking lot matching the description given by the 911 caller. Upon Officer Bishop speaking with the driver, he could smell alcohol coming from her and the vehicle's interior. Officer Bishop was able to conduct a portion of the Standardized Field Sobriety Test that ended when the driver refused to complete the remaining tasks. With the clues Officer Bishop had at the time he placed the driver under arrest and transported her to the Blanco County for a breath test. The breath test proved inconclusive due a malfunction with the State operated machine, so Officer Bishop sought a blood warrant and had the subjects blood drawn at the jail. I have sent the specimen to the DPS Lab for analysis. The subject was arrested and housed at the Blanco County Jail.

On April 27th, Officer Chad Wiggins and I responded to the 1900 Block of US HWY 281 South to assist the Blanco County Sheriff's Office with a subject who had pointed a firearm at two individuals at his home and barricaded himself inside. Upon arriving witnesses stated that the suspect had made statements about killing law enforcement and himself if they tried to enter his home. Sheriff Don Jackson attempted to contact the suspect for an hour before the decision was made to forcibly enter the residence. When Deputies breached to rear door the suspect still did not answer. It wasn't until a pepper spray grenade was tossed into the house and several other windows smashed out that a reaction from the suspect was finally gained. This led to a prolonged standoff with the suspect refusing to come out. We were told by the suspect that the house was boobytrapped and we would be injured, and he would kill himself if we entered. It was at this time that the Sheriff's Office contacted Hays County Sheriff's Office who sent their SWAT team. Four hours later the situation was resolved and the suspect surrendered to the SWAT Team. Officer Wiggins and I assisted with the transport of the suspect so Blanco County personnel could remain on scene.

The City held Court on 4/28/21. The Court almost doubled its Docket, and we had a good response. The Docket include a mixture of case types. Judge Walston and I have started discussing the dates for future Dockets, as this will make it easier for Defendants to address their cases, particularly if they need to be reset or extended. Some cases closed out within a few days, and Deferrals and Payment Plans for cases have been started, as well.

Judge Walston and I recently watched an Amnesty Hearing in Victoria, TX. The Hearing was informative, and we both took notes while observing.

The New Clerks Seminar will be held in July, and the Court Administrators Conference will be held in June. Judge Walston is looking forward to signing up for July's New Judges Seminar. We are both excited to receive additional instruction from experts in municipal court law.

We closed April with the City's incoming collections totaling \$8,887.55, after subtracting the State's remittance. We disposed of 32 cases. We started the month with 1,333 pending cases, and we ended with 1,325 pending cases.
