



**PETITION FOR VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION

Local Government Code Chapter 43, Subchapter C-3, provides the statutory rules for voluntary annexations in Texas. I desire to enter into a written agreement for municipal services with the City, pursuant to Section 43.0672 of the Local Government Code. If any portion of the property is appraised for ad valorem tax purposes as agricultural, wildlife management use, or timber land under Chapter 23 of the Tax Code, I certify that I was offered a development agreement, pursuant to Section 43.016 of the Local Government Code and still requested annexation. Annexed areas are automatically zoned Single Family; however, a landowner can request rezoning at the same time he / she submits the annexation request.
