

Revised Total Coliform Rule (RTCR) Failure to Report Monitoring Events to the State that are
Not Related to *E. coli*-positive Sample Results

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
Reporting Requirement(s) Not Met for CITY OF JOHNSON CITY PWS 0160001

We are required to report the results of monitoring of your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis by DEC. 2020. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During DEC. 2020, we did not report the results of monitoring for total coliform.

Our system failed to notify the State drinking water program, as required, by DEC. 2020. Although public health was not impacted, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other actions.

What is being done?

In order to return to compliance, our system was required to collect a complete round of distribution samples within the correct compliance period. We did collect our monthly distribution samples on 01/20/2021 and we returned to compliance.
