EMECUTIVE SUMMANT:				

Timothy Jung, owner/operator of Reck'em Right Brewing Co., submitted an Encroachment License Agreement application for an existing barbecue trailer located on City right-of-way for City Council review and approval on February 2, 2021. The Council approved the Encroachment License Agreement.

Moreover, the City Council reapproved - subject to a 6-month review - a Conditional Use Permit for the same on November 2, 2021; six months expires on May 2, 2022.

FINANCIAL:

If approved, Mr. Jung will be required to pay \$179.00 for the extension of the previously-approved Encroachment License Agreement. The Encroachment License Agreement expires annually on February 2nd, and it automatically renews following payment of the requisite fee.
