We have slowly been receiving inquires for the SRO and Patrol positions. Several background checks have been started on applicants with some being unfavorable. The Police Department continues to repost weekly on various job boards to keep our postings updated. I will keep the Council posted on application and backgrounds as they progress.

Public Safety

On 10-22-2022, Lt. Garrett Scallorn responded to a physical disturbance at Fat Boy Burgers located at 104 N. US HWY 281. Upon his arrival he observed two males in a physical altercation in the courtyard area of the restaurant. Lt. Scallorn gave several verbal commands to the two individuals to stop fighting. It was at this point that he recognized one of the subjects involved in the fight and called out to him to stop. This individual did stop but the other subject continued his assault. It was at this point that Lt. Scallorn made the decision to use his TASER on the subject who was now punching and kicking the other party involved. The deployment of the TASER was effective and Lt. Scallorn was able to take the male into custody. North Blanco County EMS responded to the scene to evaluate all parties, and none required medical treatment. I reviewed all video and reports submitted in this case and have determined that the use of force used during this arrest was appropriate. The suspect in this case was arrested and released to the custody of the Blanco County Jail.
